

There are 2 main International Airports in Kuala Lumpur
- Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)
- Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2 (KLIA2)

There are several ways to get to the city centre from the airport.

We have handpicked 3 of the best mode of transportation to ease your journey here at Kuala Lumpur.

The Conference Venue, Hilton Kuala Lumpur Hotel is situated next to KL Sentral Station.

1 KLIA Ekspres (Airport Train)



Kuala Lumpur's fastest airport transfer (KLIA Ekspres) takes you from Kuala Lumpur International Airports (KLIA | KLIA2) to the city (KL Sentral) in less than an hour

Estimated Journey Time

- 28 minutes (KLIA – KL Sentral)
- 33 minutes (KLIA2 – KL Sentral)

Operating Hours

First Train departs | 05:00

Last Train departs | 01:00

Frequency

- Every 15 minutes during peak hours
- Every 20 minutes at off-peak hours
- Every 30/40 minutes after midnight

2 Airport Taxi



Taxi services are available at KLIA / KLIA2 around the clock.

Airport Taxi counters are available at the Arrival Hall where you can hire a metered taxi. You will then travel approximately 62km to the hotel, which will take approximately 45 minutes with smooth traffic.

The estimated taxi fare would be RM100 – RM150.

Midnight charges may apply between 12.00am to 6.00am.

Note: Please purchase your taxi coupon from the taxi counter before you exit the arrival gate.

3 GRAB Malaysia



Similar to Uber, GRAB is the Ride Sharing App, which is widely used in Malaysia.

A few months back, GRAB has acquired all of Uber's Southeast Asia operations, making it the largest Ride Sharing platform available.

You can download GRAB's app on your mobile prior to your trip to Malaysia. It is available on both Android and iOS.

The estimated GRAB cost from the airport to the city centre, would be around RM65 - RM 105.

By Train From Kuala Lumpur International Airport

As you head out to the Arrival Hall, after custom, you should be able to see the “Welcome to Malaysia” signboard right ahead of you.

If you are taking the KLIA Ekspres Train to KL Sentral, you can take either the lift or escalator to Level 1.

Upon arriving at Level 1, look out for the KLIA Ekspres Ticket Counter.

You may choose to purchase your ticket at the counter or using the machines.

Note: The machine(s) only accept payment via Visa / Mastercard.

Upon entering the boarding area, do make sure that you are boarding on to the right train. As there are two separate platforms, Platform A & Platform B.

If in doubt, you may check with any KLIA Ekspres Staff.
